Provide adequate ventilation	Aerosol	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Doors and windows kept open as much as possible Use CO2 monitor. If CO2 above 1500ppm: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> take a break (everyone leaves the room) ventilate the room 	Committee member
Cleaning routine	Surface	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Venue cleaned and bins emptied regularly Members bring their own equipment where possible (e.g., hand sanitiser, music stands, sheet music, rosin, valve oil, wax, mutes, etc.) Wind/brass players to collect own liquid emissions 	Venue staff All members when feasible Wind/brass players
Enable members to check in at venue	Aerosol, droplet, surface	Attendance to be monitored via Muzodo	MD's will be able to provide attendance lists if required
Communicate and train	Aerosol, droplet, surface	Risk assessment sent to all members, supplemented with COVID-19 Protocol and verbal reminders at rehearsals	Committee member
Social distancing/flow of people	Droplet	No social distancing but members ask to respect each other's space	All members
Singing	Aerosol, droplet	Currently no singing at Orchestra and Band rehearsals	N/A
Refreshments	Surface	No refreshments provided. Members bring their own	All members
